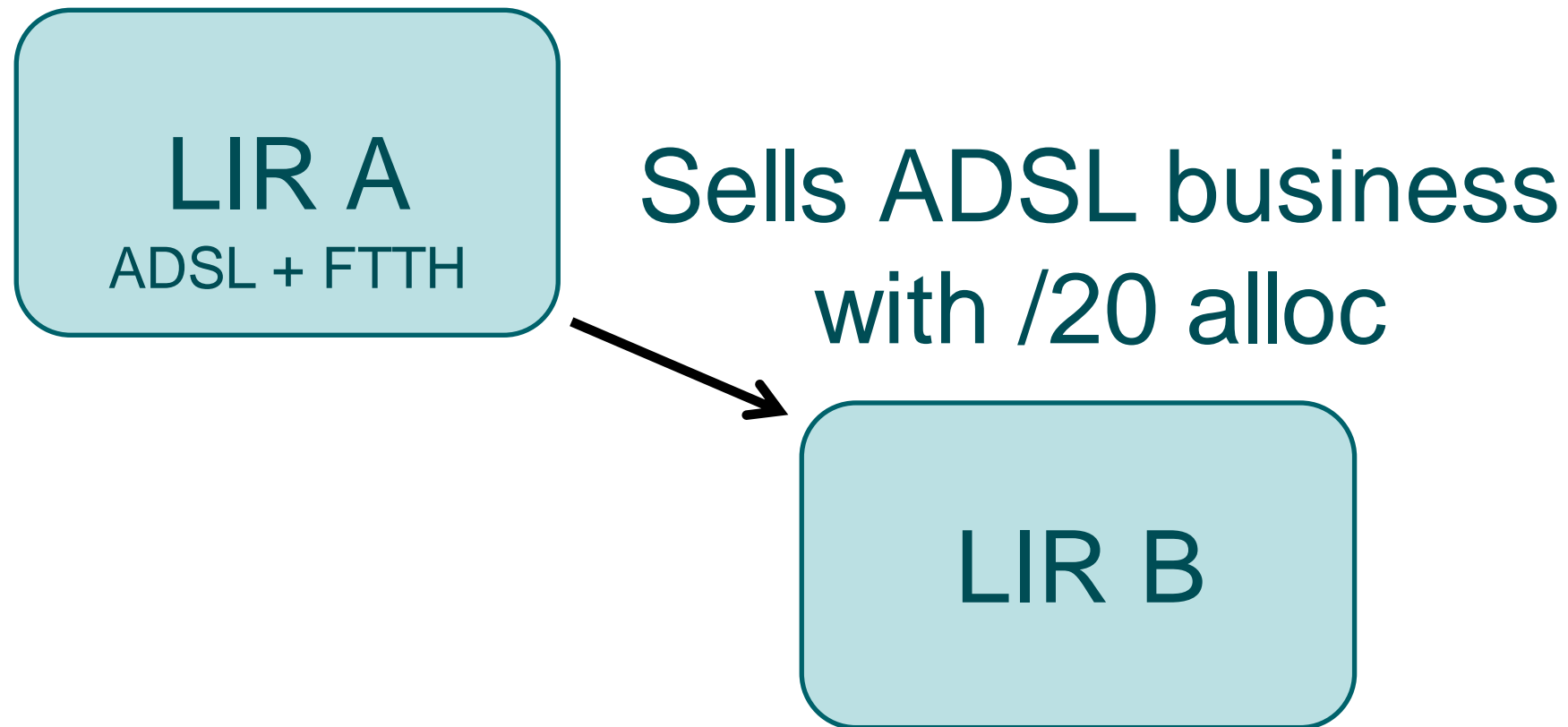
5.5 Transfers of Allocations

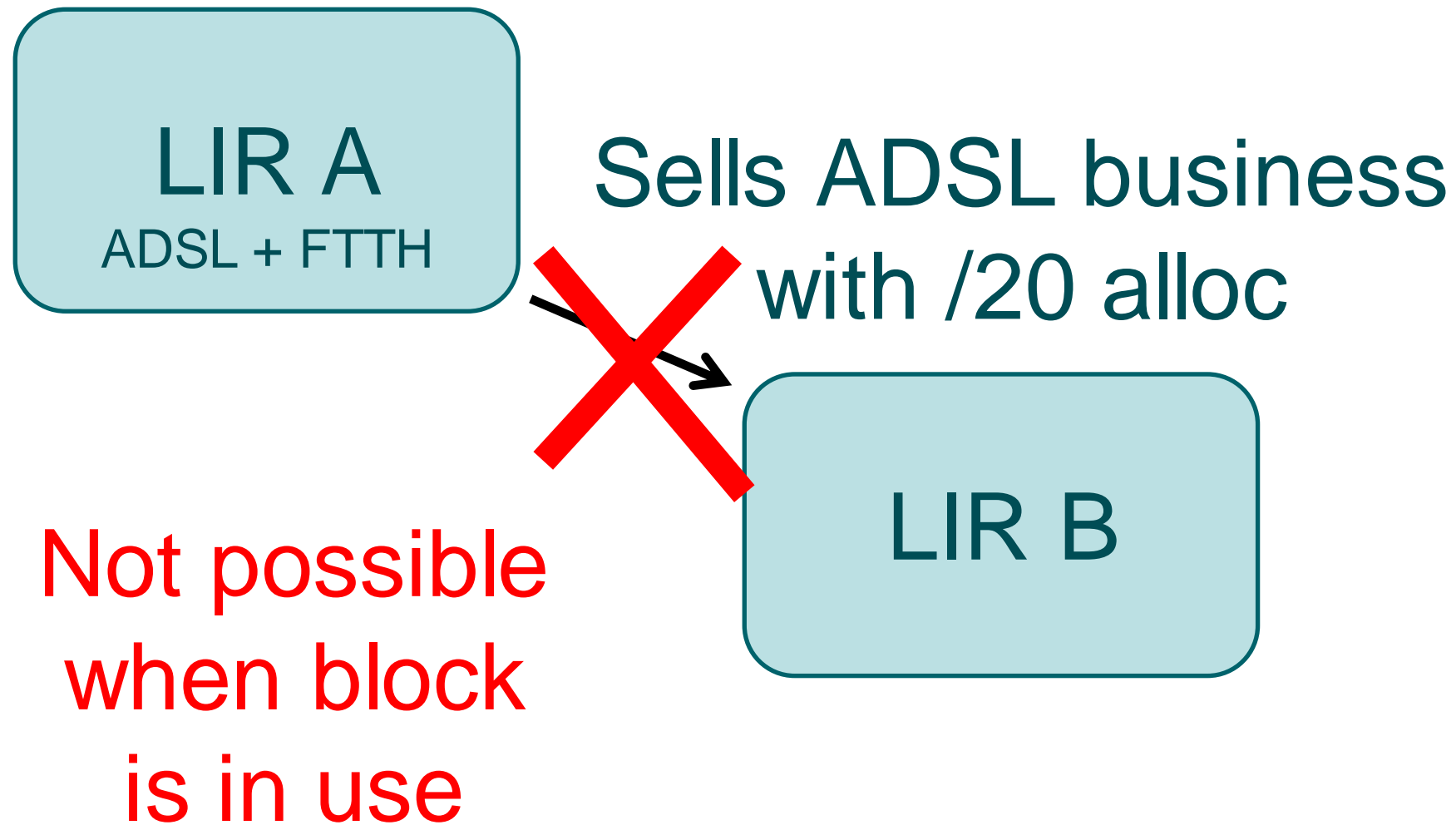
