

- A big year so far
- More than 850 new members since January





## An Evolving Member Base

- We have many new members (< 2 years old)</li>
- We have members with differing needs & issues, at various stages of development
- The community composition is more diverse
- We must engage with our entire membership across our entire service region

#### The Current Landscape

- Operationally, we are strong
  - Continuously seeking the right balance between bureaucracy and protecting the accuracy of the registry
- But the Internet landscape is constantly developing and changing
  - Development of an IPv4 market (IPv4 transfers and number resource hijackings)
  - Increased focus on security
  - Higher and more diverse expectations



## Looking at 2014: Registry and Measurements

The Registry's accuracy remains paramount

- Tools and measurements
  - We are and want to remain a trusted source
  - Further cooperation to realise the value for members
  - Consolidation of collection tools under RIPE Atlas
  - A single data retrieval interface: RIPEstat



#### Looking at 2014: Outreach

- Regional outreach
  - In line with the evolving membership base
  - Strengthening our community by engaging and reaching out to members throughout our region
  - -Supporting local communities, within the RIPE community, to meet their needs
- Building bridges between the technical community and other parties beyond our membership
