Where are we now?

- Number of LIRs ~ 9000
- abuse-c contacts added ~ 4000
- still to be added ~ 5000

Networks covered

- IPv4 allocations ~ 57%
- IPv6 allocations ~ 58%
- IPv4 PI assignments ~ 6%
- IPv6 assignment ~ 14%
- IPv4 allocated address space ~ 62%
- IPv4 assigned PI address space ~ 12%

Simplified UI for adding abuse-c

- To be deployed shortly after RIPE 67
- Log into LIR Portal
- Enter email address
- DONE
- The software will do everything else

Deadline for LIRs

- It was agreed all LIRs should have abuse-c by end of Q3 – now!!
- We have listened to your comments
- The new UI should help
- Propose extending deadline to end November
- After that date all remaining LIRs will have it set up for them by default

PI space

- Propose delaying start of this phase until end of November
- Provide new simplified UI for PI holders
 - Enter org id, mntner password, email address
 - DONE
- The software will do everything else

References to abuse-c

- Currently only from organisation object
- Some users find duplicating org a problem
- Allowing references from multiple locations is also a problem
- RIPE NCC acknowledges this is a problem
- Propose to take an in depth look at options
- Come back to WG with suggestions for improvement
