



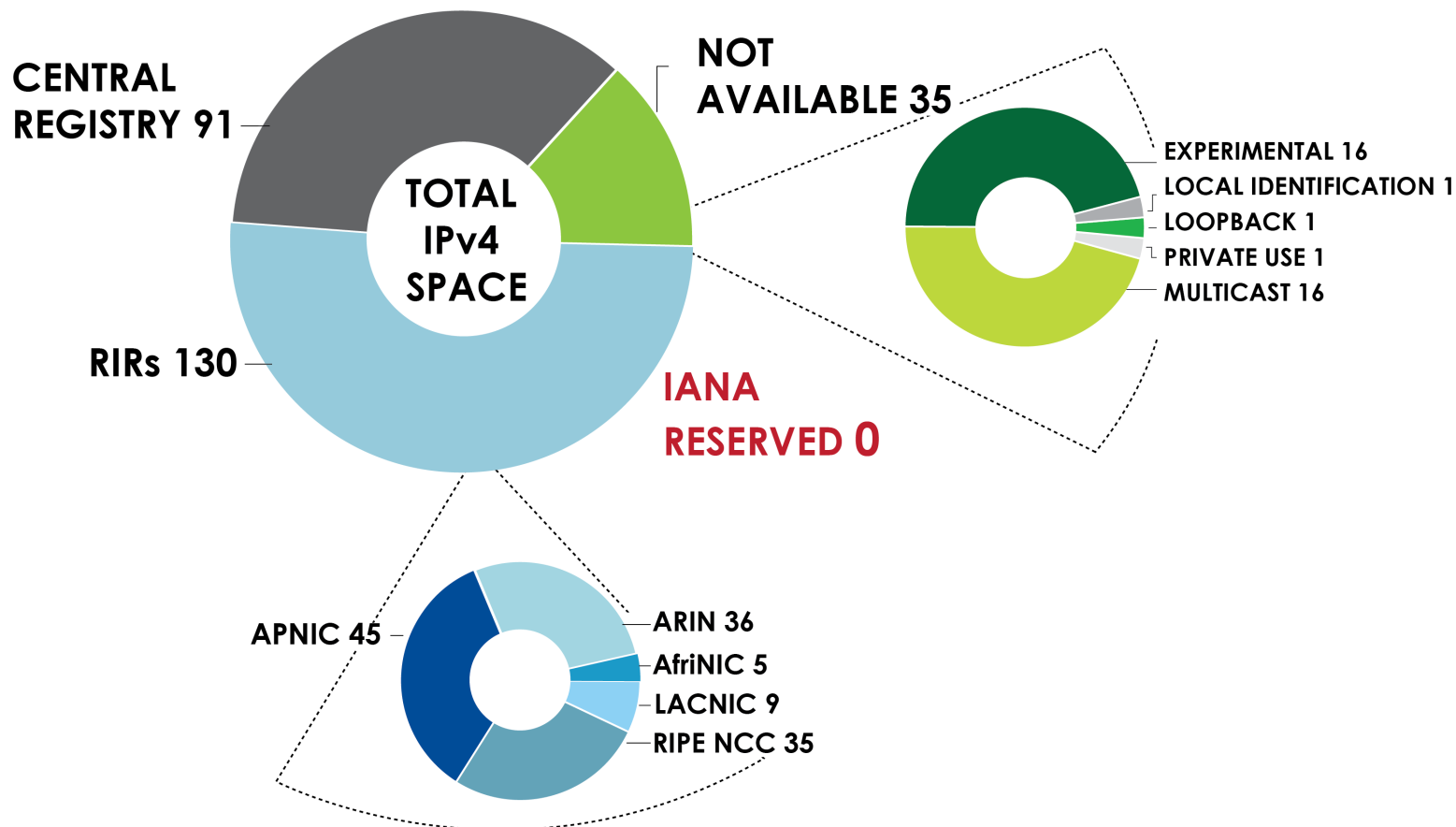

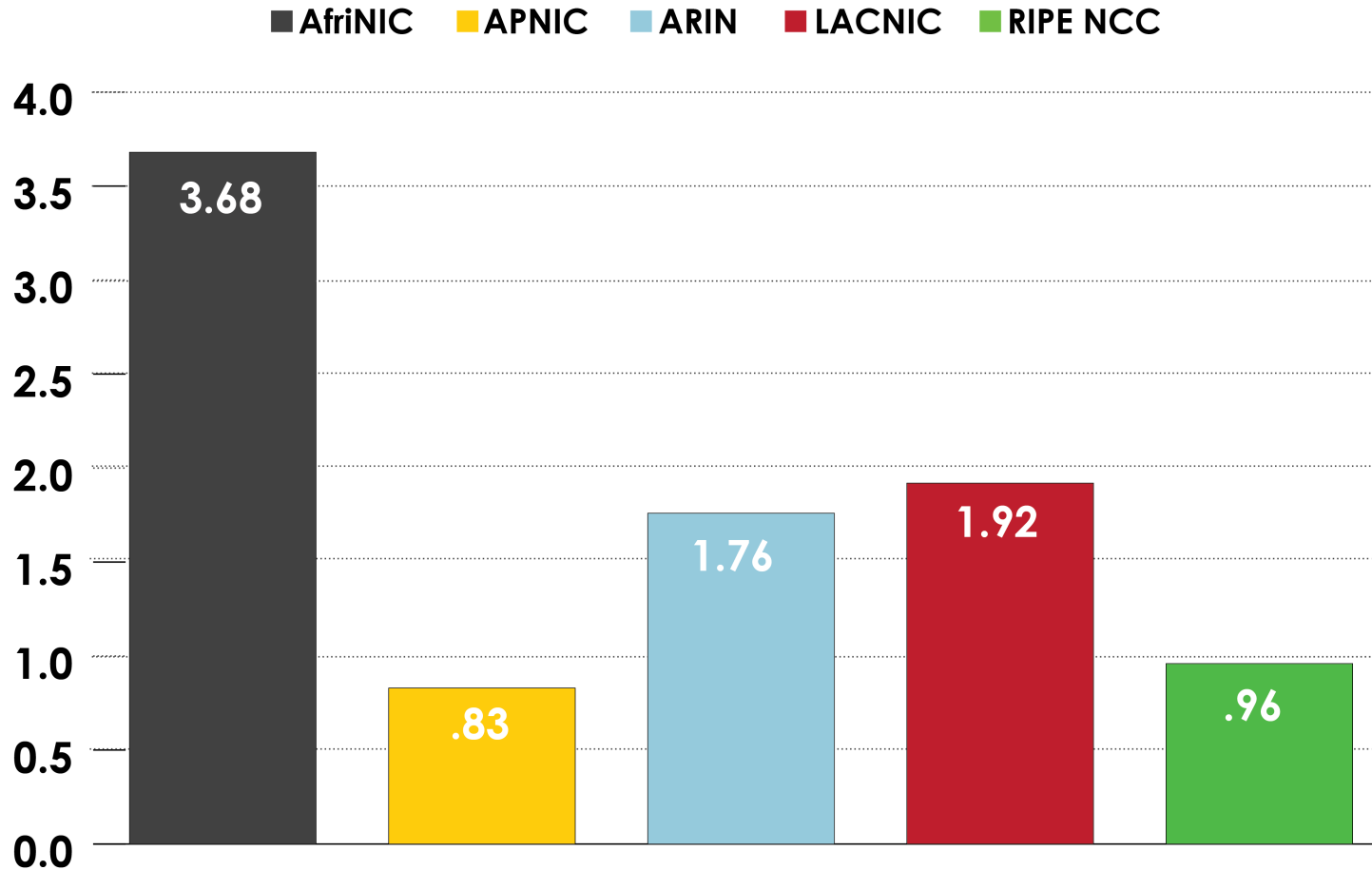

STATUS OF 256 /8s IPv4 ADDRESS SPACE

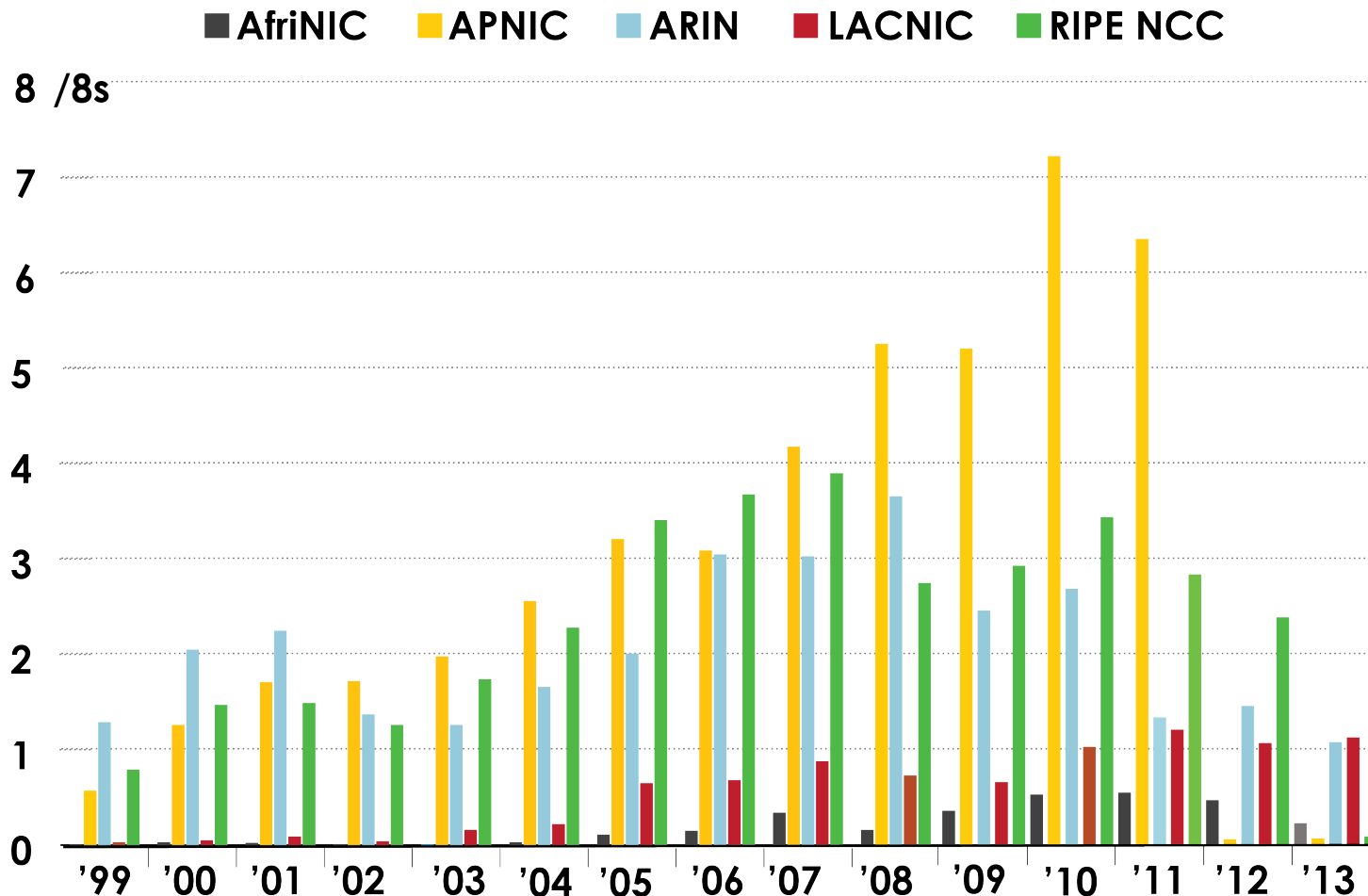


AVAILABLE IPv4 /8s IN EACH RIR



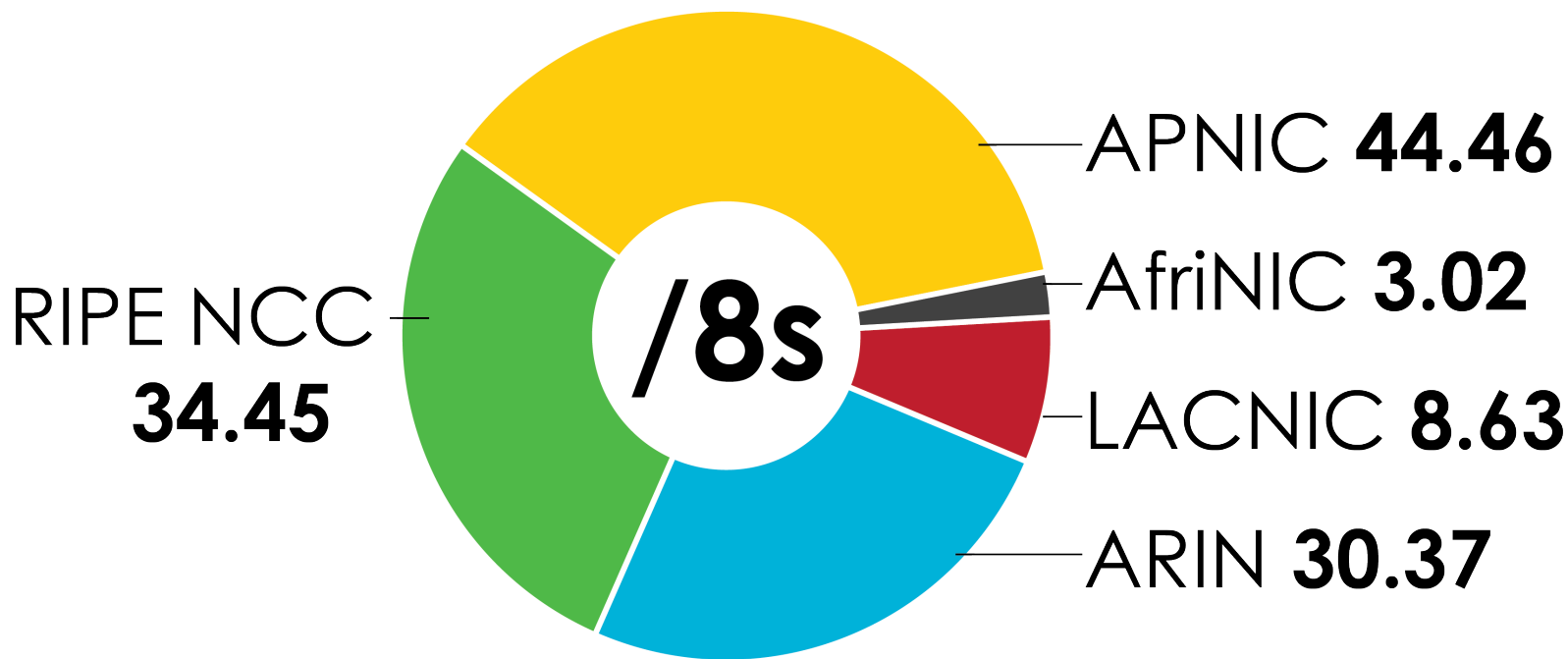
IPv4 ADDRESS SPACE ISSUED (RIRs TO CUSTOMERS)

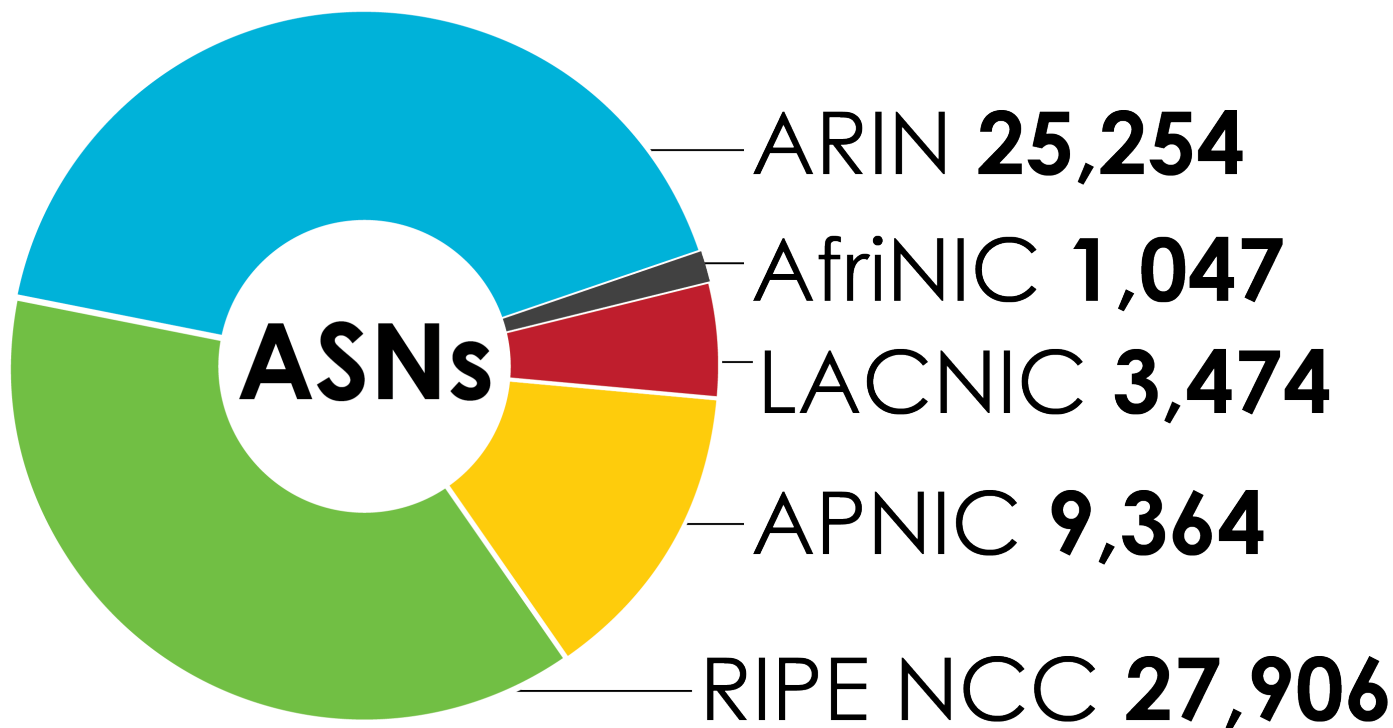
In terms of /8s, how much total space has each RIR issued?

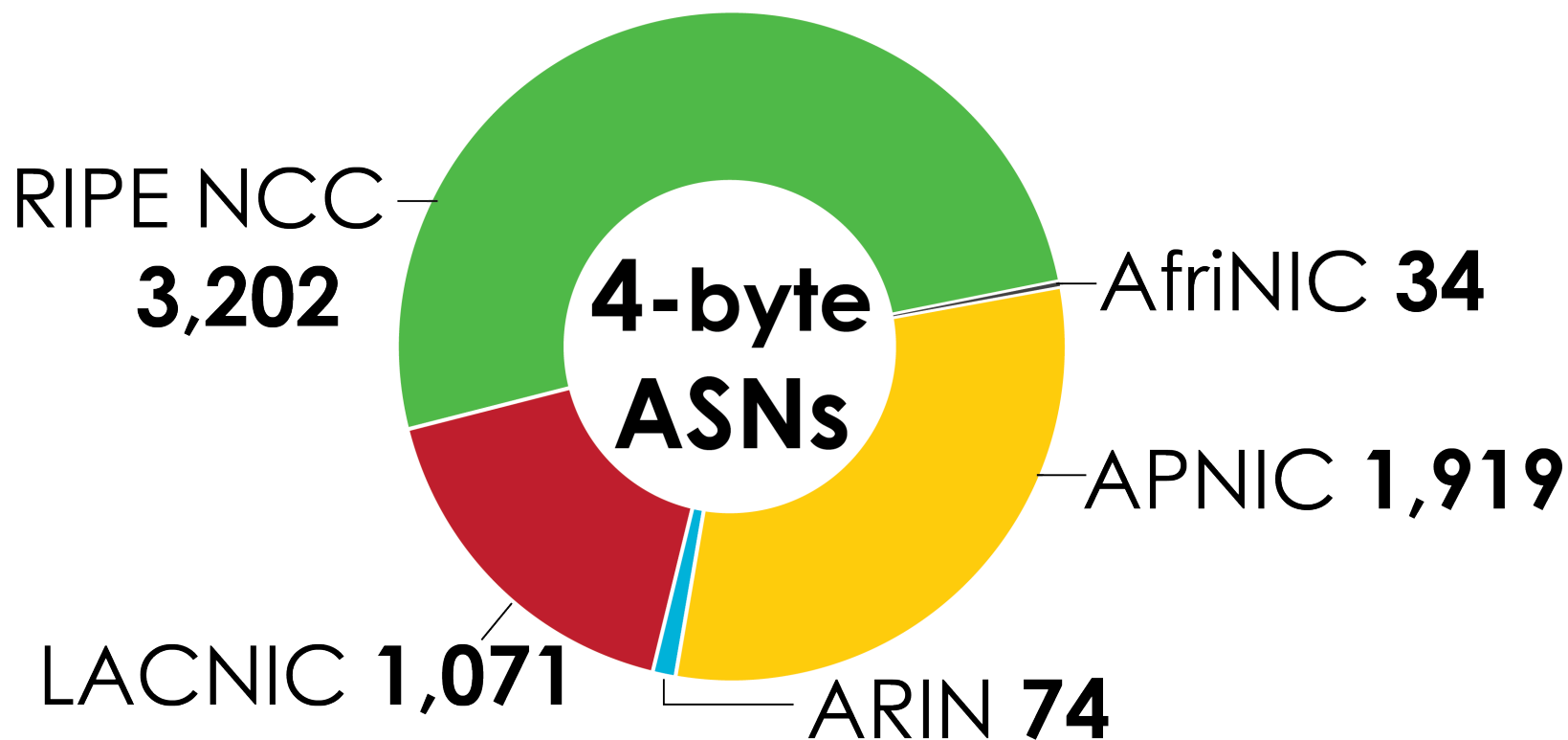
ASN ASSIGNMENTS (RIRs TO CUSTOMERS)

(Jan 1999 – Sep 2013)



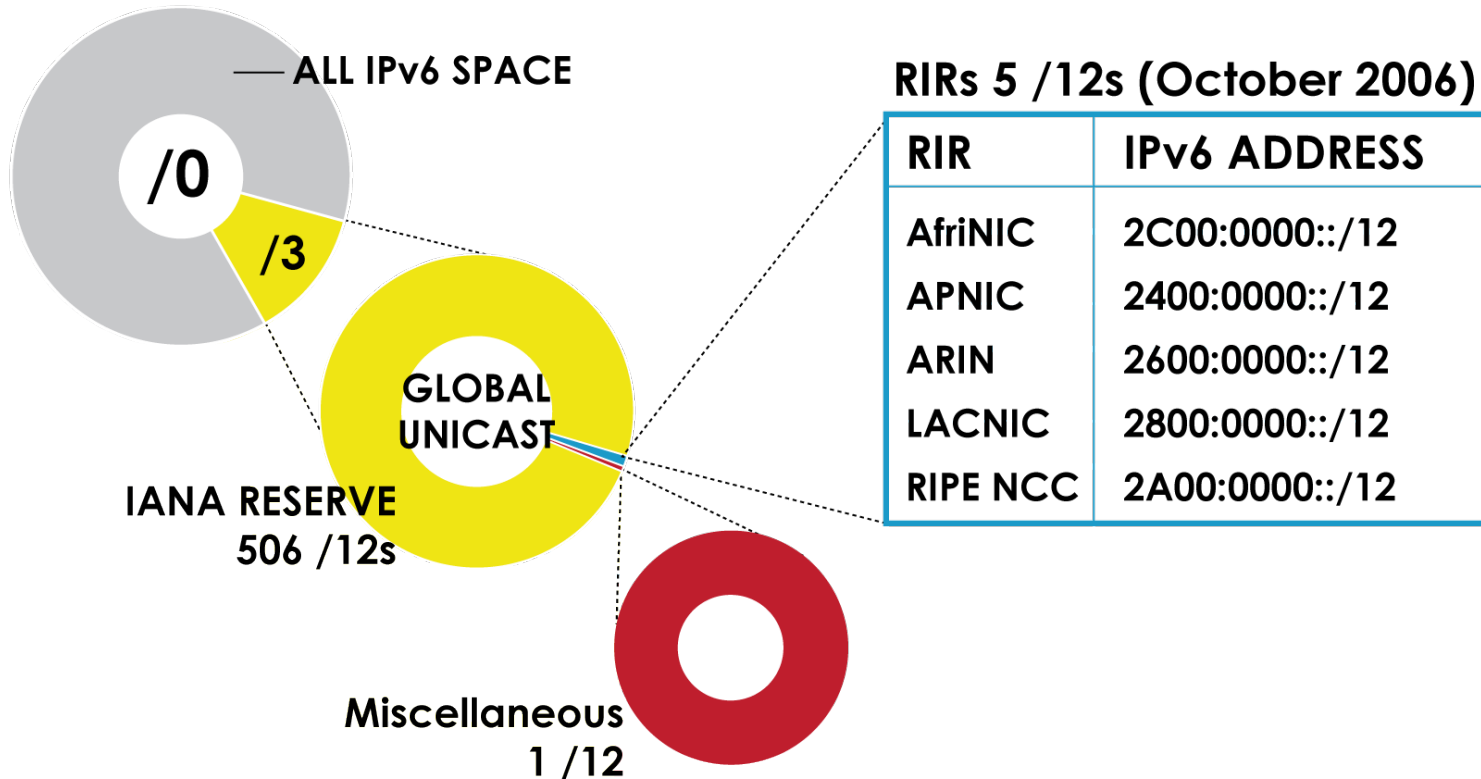
4-BYTE ASN ASSIGNMENTS

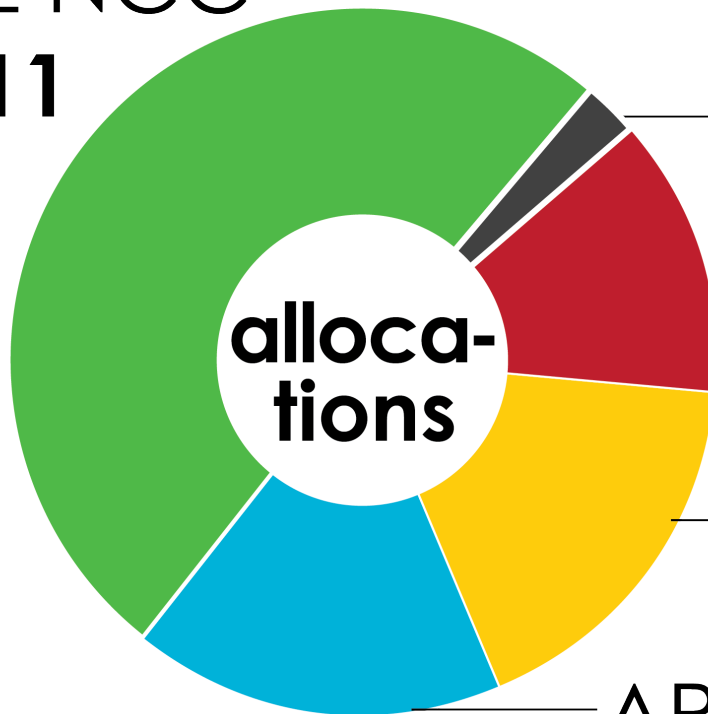
How much has been allocated to the RIRs?

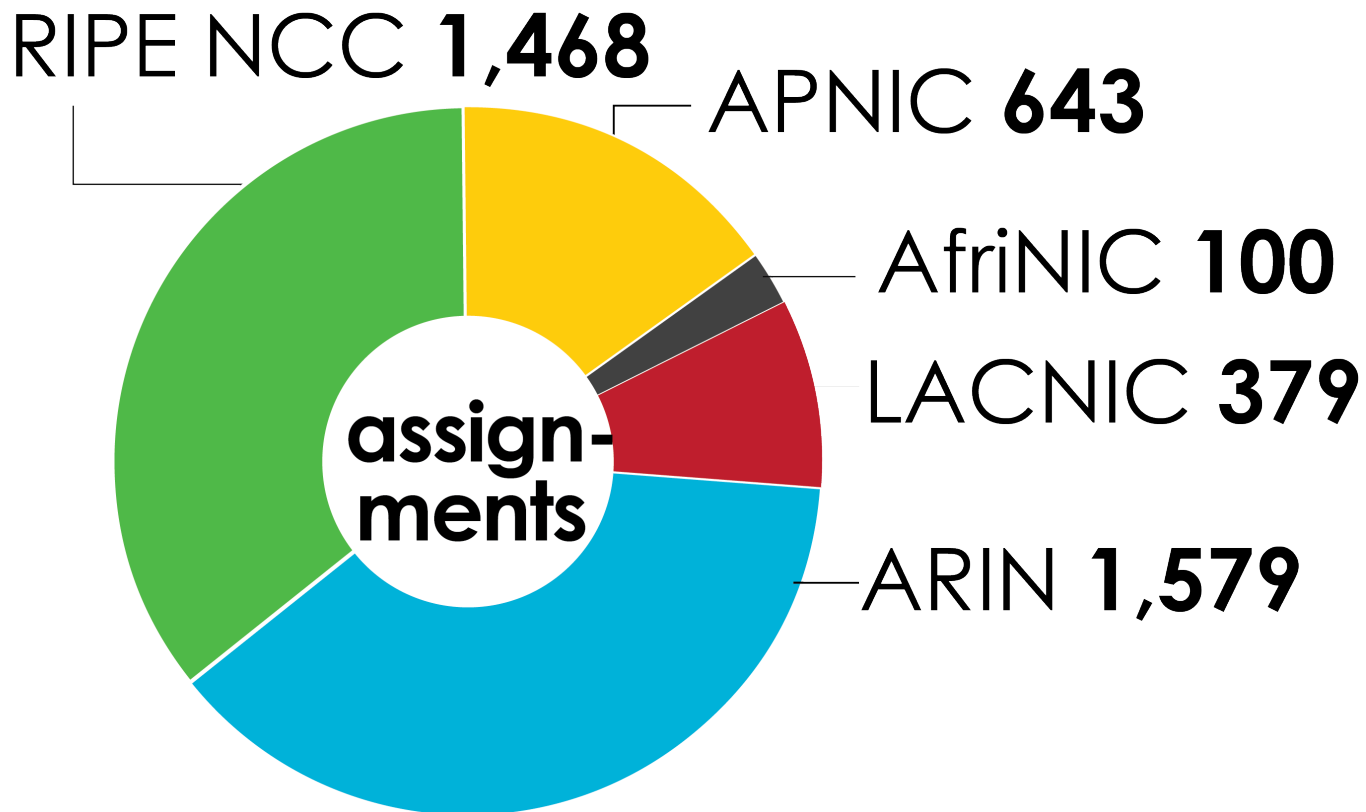

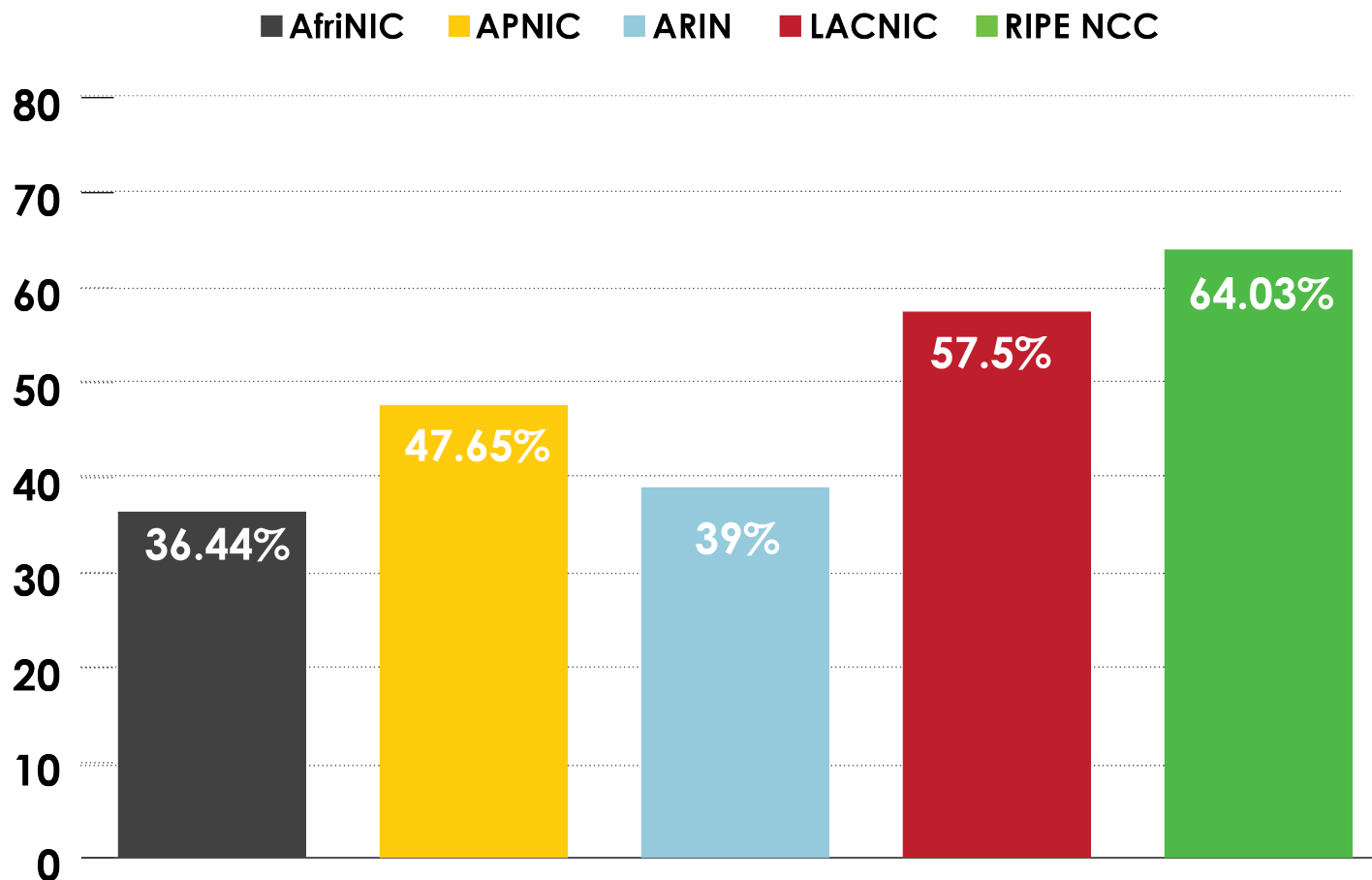


IPv6 ASSIGNMENTS (RIRs TO END-USERS)
